



2010 THP-Plus Institute: Re-Visioning Transitional Housing in the Era of AB 12

The THP-Plus Implementation Project is sponsored by the John Burton Foundation for Children, the California Department of Social Services and the Corporation for Supportive Housing.

The THP-Plus Statewide Implementation Project is a partnership between the John Burton Foundation, the Corporation for Supportive Housing and the California Department of Social Services.

The goal of the Project is to reduce homelessness among California's former foster care and probation youth by expanding access to the Transitional Housing Placement-Plus (THP-Plus) program, California's only housing program targeting this growing population.

THP-Plus provides affordable housing and comprehensive supportive services to help former foster care and probation youth ages 18 to 24 make a successful transition from out-of-home placements to independent living.

By the date of the 2010 THP-Plus Institute, AB 12 will either be signed into state law or back to the legislative starting blocks. Either outcome has serious implications for THP-Plus. Please join us on Monday, November 8th for an important day of conversation and training about THP-Plus. Eight workshops will be provided, broken into a policy track and a practice track. If passed, considerable coverage will be provided to AB 12 and its implications for THP-Plus.
